PLANNED FACTORY SHUTDOWN FOR MAINTENANCE

The factory has run for 9 months since resumption from Interim repairs which were undertaken between May and August of 2020.

These repairs were projected to give a life line of 6 – 8 months – which have since elapsed. As a result, we have of late experienced frequent and long breakdowns/downtimes which have adversely affected productions and extension financial performance.

In view of this situation, Management has made a decision to shutdown for Annual Plant maintenance with effect from **7th June 2021**.

This exercise is planned to take about 6 weeks after which we expect significant improvement in performance.

The Company appeals to all Stakeholders to note and compliment this exercise, especially with required critical supplies and other support.
